



Required documents for Vaccination certificate of COVID-19 application

□Application form

□Passport copy



□Certificate or copy of Inoculation, Vaccination record(Vaccination Voucher)

□Proof of your residential address

□[Cases where the passport holder's name is different from the vaccination voucher, such as written in your former name, another surname or another name]

Please bring a document (copy is acceptable) to identify both of your names.

□[Cases when you are not able to apply by yourself]

A proxy letter which you(applicant) signed is required.

How to apply (By post mail or hand in to the office)

- If you need to certify in Japan that you have been vaccinated, the vaccination record you receive after getting the vaccination is also valid.
- The Vaccination Certificate will be delivered by post mail. It may take about a week. We therefore recommend you to apply for it as soon as possible.
- If the form is not sufficiently filled in or the required attached documents are missing, we will not be able to issue the Vaccination Certificate. Please check carefully before application.
- Your passport number will be written on the Vaccination Certificate. Please apply with the passport you will be using to travel.
- An e-certificate can be issued as well. Please check the site below to see how to apply for it. (machine translation)
