From June, the Way of Disposing of Recyclable Plastic Waste Will Change

To dispose of recyclable plastic waste, specific bags must be purchased at stores.

What is recyclable plastic?:

Snack bags, foam trays, refill bags, plastic wrap, foam fruit nets, caps and labels of plastic bottles, detergent and shampoo bottles, mayonnaise tubes, egg cartons, Styrofoam, plastic shopping bags, blister packs of contact lenses, toothbrushes, rulers, dish sponges, clothes hangers, compact disks, buckets, shower bench, washbowl, etc.
