

# Follow the Rules for Safe Cycling

Please follow the rules when riding a bicycle. If you do not follow them, you may be caught by the police and required to pay a fine.

The Five Rules for Safe Cycling:

1. Ride on the left side of the road. If the road is not safe and you ride on the sidewalk, be careful of pedestrians.
2. Follow the traffic signals. At intersections, stop and check for safety.
3. Turn on your lights at night.
4. Do not ride a bicycle after drinking alcohol.
5. Wear a helmet.

There are other rules for riding a bicycle as well.
