

Additional Public Assistance Benefits

The national government has decided to provide additional public assistance benefits to eligible residents of Kokubunji City. Please note that application procedures may vary depending on your 'financial' status.

Who is Eligible?

Anyone who received public assistance benefits in Kokubunji City between August 2013 and March 31, 2026.

How to Receive the Benefits

- If you are currently receiving public assistance benefits in Kokubunji City:

No application is required.

You will receive the additional benefits between October 2026 and March 31, 2027.

- If you received public assistance benefits in Kokubunji City between August 2013 and March 31, 2026 (and are not currently receiving it):

An application is required. Please apply using one of the following methods:
